

Guidelines for Children's Birthday Celebrations

We kindly ask you to follow these guidelines for the celebration of your child's birthday party to optimise the booking as well as the celebration of the birthday itself. Please bring with you a signed copy of these guidelines when visiting the museum or send it to us in advance with your confirmation of reservation! Thanks a lot.

1. All birthday celebrations are only offered within the museum's opening hours (Tuesdays to Sundays from 10:00 to 17:00).
2. All children taking part in the birthday celebrations must be at least 4 years old and have to be able to use the bathroom on their own. For more precise age restrictions, please check with the individual programmes. We do not recommend that the age difference between the children exceeds 4 years.
3. The children's birthday celebrations are designed for a maximum of 10 children (higher number of participants on request). The price for each programme applies to the whole package and has to be paid in advance at the museum's cash point.
4. The children's birthday parties will take place in the absence of parents or adult attendants. For the duration of the programme, those can, of course, visit the museum (by paying the fee valid for the respective site).
5. During the celebration, the museum staff will be accountable for the supervision of the children. Guardians should still instruct their children on general rules of conduct within the museum.
6. Food and beverages can be brought from home by the parents. The decoration for the tables will be provided by the museum staff. Please take into account that no food and beverages can be heated within the museum.
